PUBLIC SPEAKS:



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1. Mitch Ciccarone wanted to express that he does not believe the statements being made that townships have outgrown their usefulness. He said that he and his wife moved to Plain Township because of the bureaucracy going on in the City of Canton and is very happy to live in the township. Concerning the proposed hotel **going in on Fulton Rd., he said he and other residents don't buy** into the City of Canton saying that any emergencies at the hotel that Plain responds to can be reimbursed through the insurance companies. Another concern he has is with the traffic in his neighborhood, including Westmorland, Darlington, Clearview and Blake streets. He said cars do not want to wait for the light at 77 and cut through those neighborhoods to avoid it. He would like to see a traffic counter going down the hill on Clearview. He said he would also like to see the access to the entrance ramp to 77 gone. Mr. Haws stated that the Township worked for almost a year trying to Reach in an agreement with the City of Canton because of those concerns however the City of Canton did a 180 at the last minute and declined to enter an agreement with Plain Township. Mr. Haws also advised Mitch that the probability of the access to the 77 on ramp made into a cul de sac was extremely low and that **ultimately it would be the Stark County Commissioner's decision to** vacate the road.
2. Bob Yoder addressed the Board concerning trash pickup in his neighborhood. He said the trash trucks are coming at 4am and waking up residents. He wanted to see if there is anything the Township can do to stop them from coming before 6am. Mr. Haws said they are looking at some language Jackson Twp. has about this issue and the issue needs to go before the Zoning Commission to approve or deny. Bob said he used to live in Jackson Twp. and the trash issue was enforced by the police. Mr. Williams addressed Capt. Springer about whether this is allowed. He said there has to be a Home Rule for the police to ticket the trash truck drivers. Mr. Leno said that as a Trustee, this issue would be more effective for Bob if he came in with other residents in the neighborhood that are bothered by this, as opposed to one person wanting to make a change. Mr. Sabo said he empathizes with Bob, but said he believes these companies want to get into problem areas as early as possible to avoid problems. Mr. Haws said the Board will look into the issue and see if they can get it resolved.
