WHEREAS, the Plain Township Trustees wishes to establish a Reserve Balance Account for the above described purposes;

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED; that pursuant to attached ORC Section 5705.132, we hereby establish a Reserve Balance Account as follows:

- 1. Establish a Reserve Balance Account used to accumulate currently available resources in the Fire Levy Fund for the **cost of future employee's salaries, benefits and other related** costs.
- 2. Authorize the transfer of \$175,000.00 from Account 10-A-08 Tools & Equipment to be deposited in a special fund for Fire Department future employee's salaries, benefits and other related costs named Fire Levy Additional Reserve Balance Account Fund 21P which said reserve balance account will continue for five (5) fiscal years, commencing March 9, 2021, and shall be established, maintained and the monies therein to be invested by the Township Fiscal Officer.
- 3. The account the funds shall be deposited into is 21-A-02P Fire Accumulative Benefits Reserve Acct.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that the Plain Township Fiscal Officer shall hereby be authorized to certify the establishment of the Fire Accumulative Benefits Reserve Acct to the Stark County Auditor and to the Auditor of the State of Ohio. Seconded by Mrs. Harless.
